The Appendix to the Decree of the Ministry of Social Affairs and Health on a List of Examples of Jobs Hazardous for Young Workers (188/2012) was amended with Decree 928/2014. The Appendix is essentially similar to that in the previous statute. The list was amended to remove job duties involving hazardous radiation, blasting work and care for laboratory animals; age limits for these jobs are provided in other legislation. Also, sub-categories were added to the descriptions of chemical hazard classifications.
