

WELCOME TO FINLAND CARD

There are 12 language versions of the Welcome to Finland guide. All the language versions are available at www.tem.fi/tervetuloa-suomeen. They can be read or printed.

Statutory stakeholders

Statutory stakeholders, which include the Finnish Immigration Service, local register offices and Finnish missions abroad, can order the guide in printed form in four languages; Finnish, Swedish, English and Russian. These parties can order the leaflet in all the other eight available languages. The leaflet instructs its audience to read the actual guide on the Ministry of Economic Affairs and Employment website.

Other parties can purchase the printed guide and leaflet for a fee. This Ministry of Economic Affairs and Employment will not cover the cost of the guides or postage, if the party ordering them is someone other than the aforementioned statutory stakeholders.

Other actors: Welcome to Finland card

Other stakeholders, including other authorities, municipalities as well as actors engaged in immigration and integration work, may order free of charge fliers the size of postcards that they can hand out to their customers. These fliers direct the customers to the online version of the guide on the Ministry of Economic Affairs and Employment website.
