WELCOME TO FINLAND CARD

Other than the so-called statutory actors (Finnish Immigration Service, Digital and Population Data Services Agency and Finnish embassies), such as other authorities, municipalities and those involved in immigration and integration work, may order free of charge fliers in the size of a postcard to be handed out to their customers. The fliers direct the customers to read the guide and brochure electronically on the website of the Ministry of Economic Affairs and Employment.

There are 12 language versions of the Welcome to Finland guide and 15 language versions of the brochure. All the language versions are available at www.tem.fi/en/welcome-to-finland. They can be read or printed. For cost reasons, other operators cannot order printed versions of the guide or brochure.
