# II Direct request 2015

Articles 7 and 15 of the Convention. The Committee invites the Government to provide information on any developments towards the implementation of the resolution concerning statistics of work, employment and labour underutilization (Resolution I), adopted by the 19th International Conference of Labour Statisticians (October 2013).

Article 8. Statistics of the structure and distribution of the economically active population. The Government indicates that the population census in Finland is based on register data. Basic census data is compiled annually and published in ILOSTAT. The Committee invites the Government to provide information on any developments towards the implementation of the resolution concerning statistics of work, employment and labour underutilization.

Finland has implemented ICLS resolution I (2013) by the legal provisions governing the EU-LFS from 2021, as set out in Regulation (EU) 2019/1700 of the European Parliament and of the Council, and in particular Commission Delegated Regulations (EU) 2020/256, 2020/257 and 2020/1640 as well as, Commission Implementing Regulations (EU) 2019/2180, 2019/2181, 2019/2240 and 2020/1642.

As to register-based data on population, the status of being employed is derived from the information on earned income. We consider this to coincide well with the definition of employment as against to other forms of work according to the 19th ICLS Resolution and have not undertaken any further actions in this respect.
