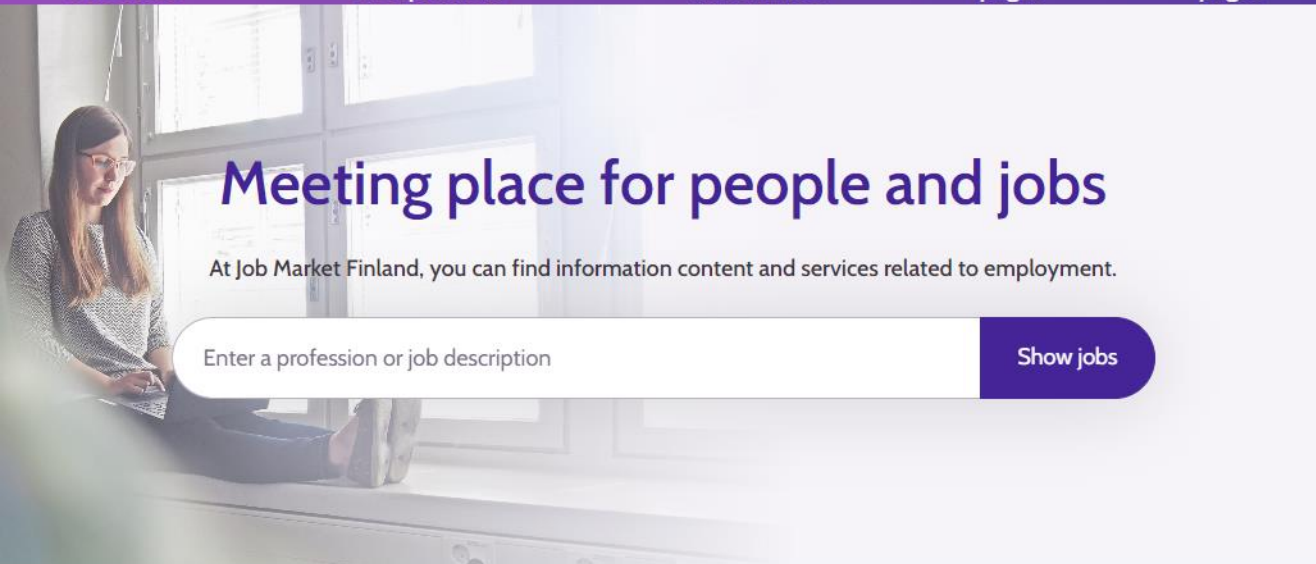

 - Get suggestions for applicants matching the job posting's skill requirements
 - Browse published profiles without posting a job and send messages.
- Personal customers and employers can also find information and services for different situations in life-event based service bundles at Job Market Finland

E-services of TE Services



In the E-services of TE Services, you can handle official matters, such as registering as a job seeker, notifying officials of a change in your work situation, or applying for a start-up grant. As an employer, you can apply for a pay subsidy and make a payment application.

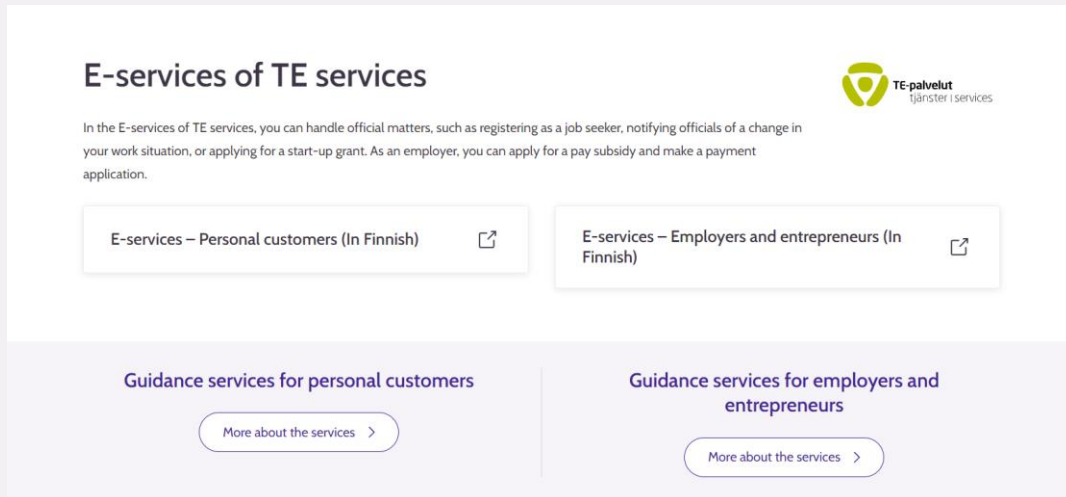

Major legal reforms concerning the organization of TE Services and the Act on the Promotion of Immigrant Integration are underway.

What will be coming next?



- Currently the E-services of TE Services can be accessed through links at Job Market Finland.
- In the future, the E-services themselves will be integrated into Job Market Finland, replacing an outdated system for customer relationship management and bringing services to one place. This will happen in stages.
- Job Market Finland is being developed by the Ministry of Economic Affairs and Employment together with the KEHA Centre.

Meeting place for jobs, people and services

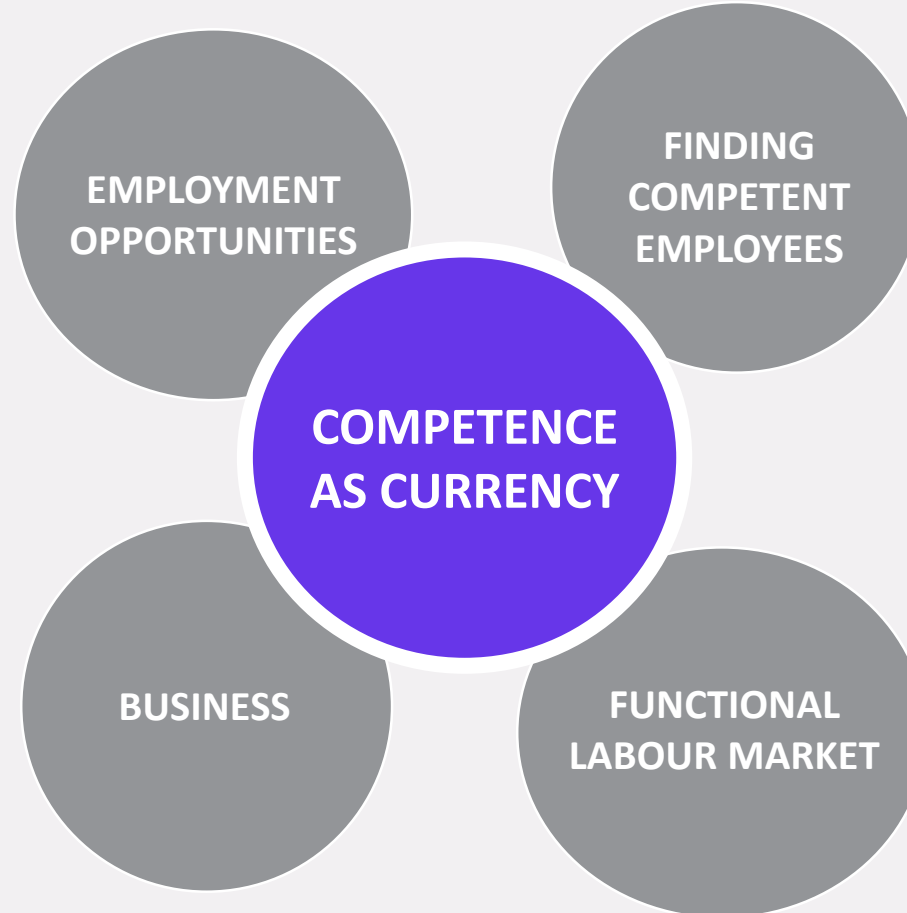
JOB SEEKERS

SERVICE ORGANISERS

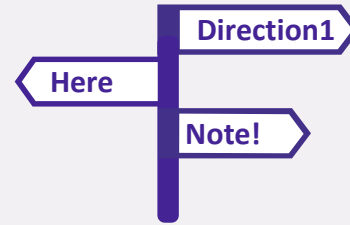
(government)

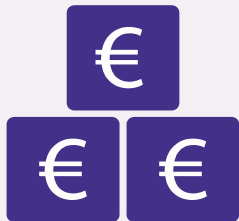

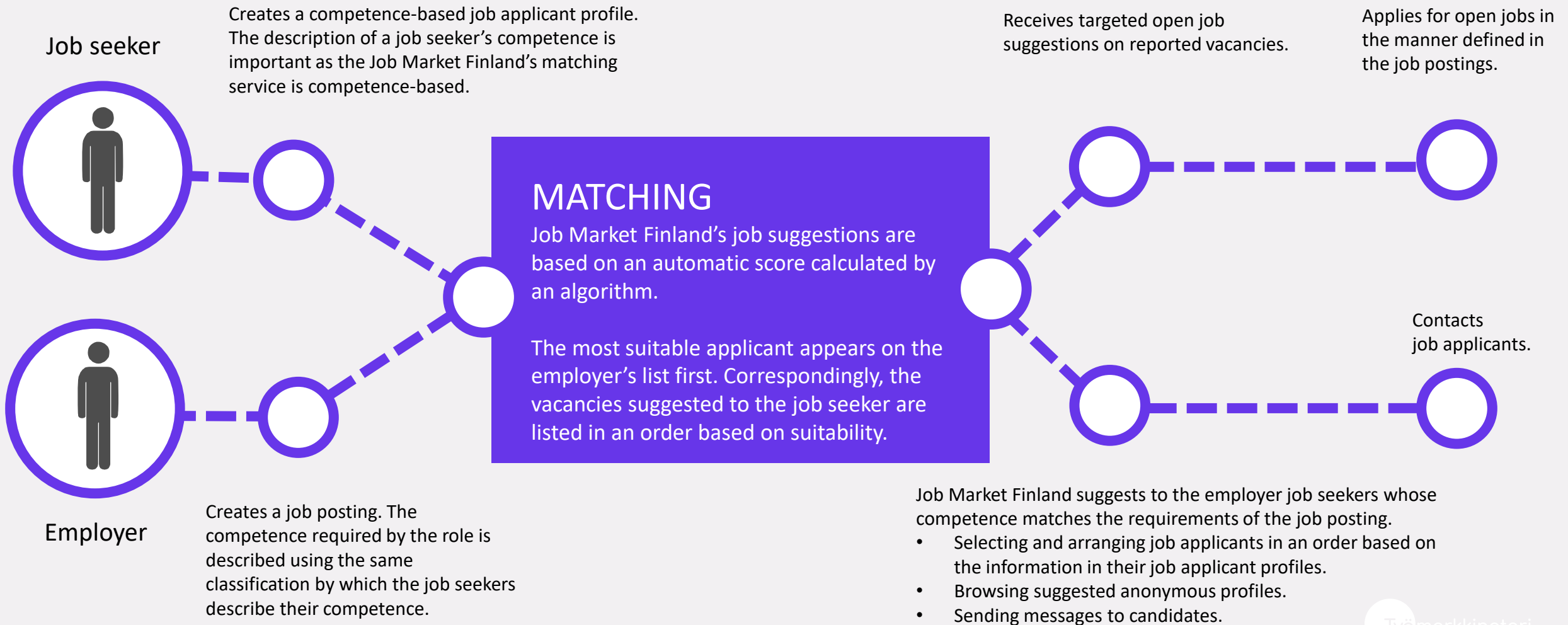

This is how Job Market Finland's matching works



AI solutions in Job Market Finland's matching

- Job Market Finland's matching algorithm uses a combination of structured information, such as skills and occupations, and natural language used in the profile and job postings (NLP)
- Relevant skills and occupations are recommended to the users based on the natural language
 - Makes skill recognition easier
- Chatbots are used to guide users, to gather feedback of the service, and for TE Services customer service
