Thank you for your email of January 23, 2024, informing Canada of the environmental impact assessment procedure of the proposed service life extension of the Olkiluoto 1 and Olkiluoto 2 plant units, and the uprating of their thermal power at the Olkiluoto nuclear power plant in Finland.

After careful consideration of the information in your letter as well as the Environmental Impact Assessment Programme, Canada is of the view that the proposed project is not likely to cause significant adverse transboundary environmental impacts in Canada.

Therefore, Canada does not intend to participate in the environmental impact assessment procedure for the proposed project.

Canada would appreciate further engagement if any new information indicating potential transboundary environmental impacts in Canada were to become available.
