

Statement on the EIA report for a Fennovoima Nuclear Plant

Vienna, 13th December, 2008

Dear Sir or Madam,

the **Viennese Platform “Nuclearfree Future”** are deeply concerned about the planned Finnish NPP project.

Nuclear power is dangerous, expensive and an absolutely outdated way of generating electricity:

- Nuclear power is neither a renewable form of energy nor can it stop climate change.
- Due to the shortage of Uranium, its price has increased twentyfold since 2000.
- The nuclear waste problem is not solved even if Finland is building a final repository.
- From Uranium mining to the final storage of nuclear waste, nuclear energy is not environmentally friendly at all.

Investing in NPPs prevents more useful solutions such as developing renewable energies!
