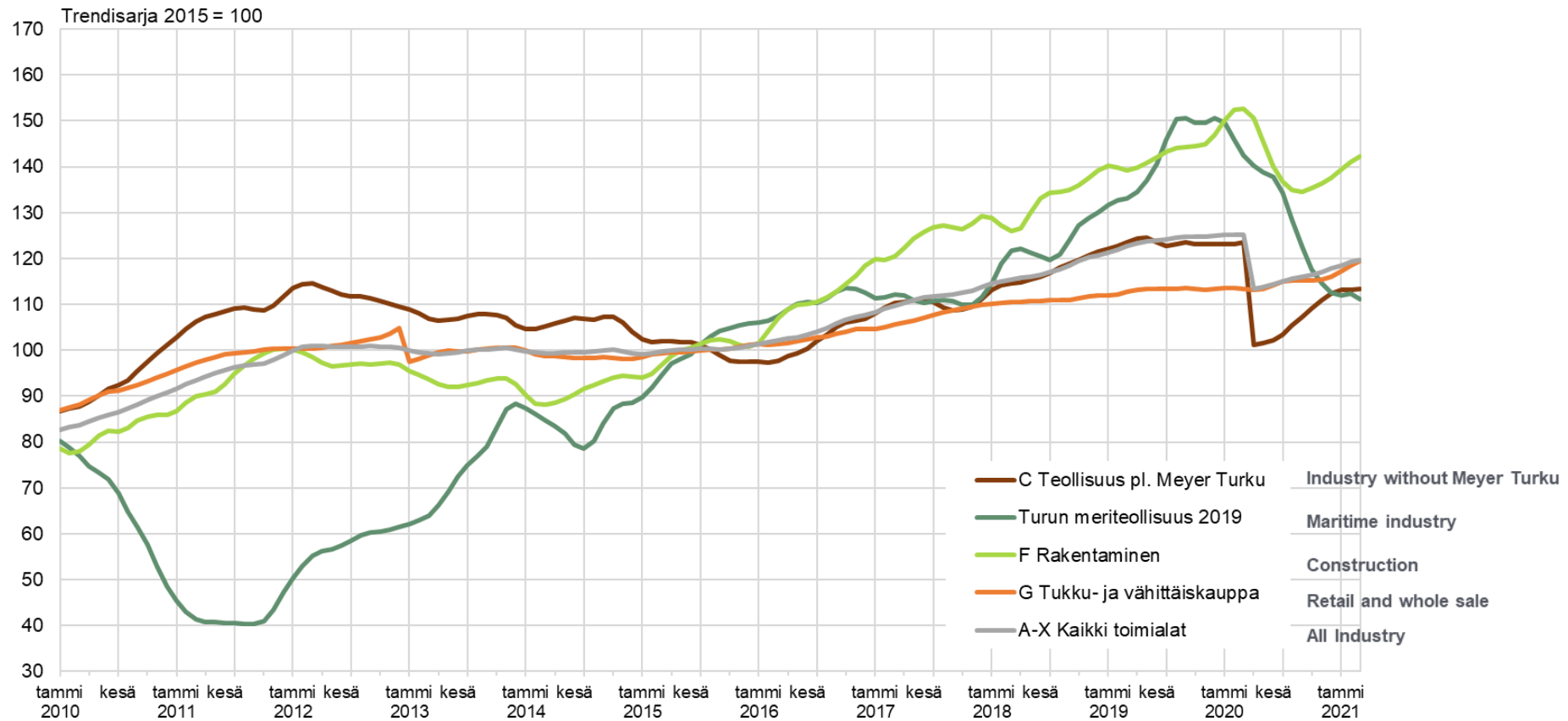

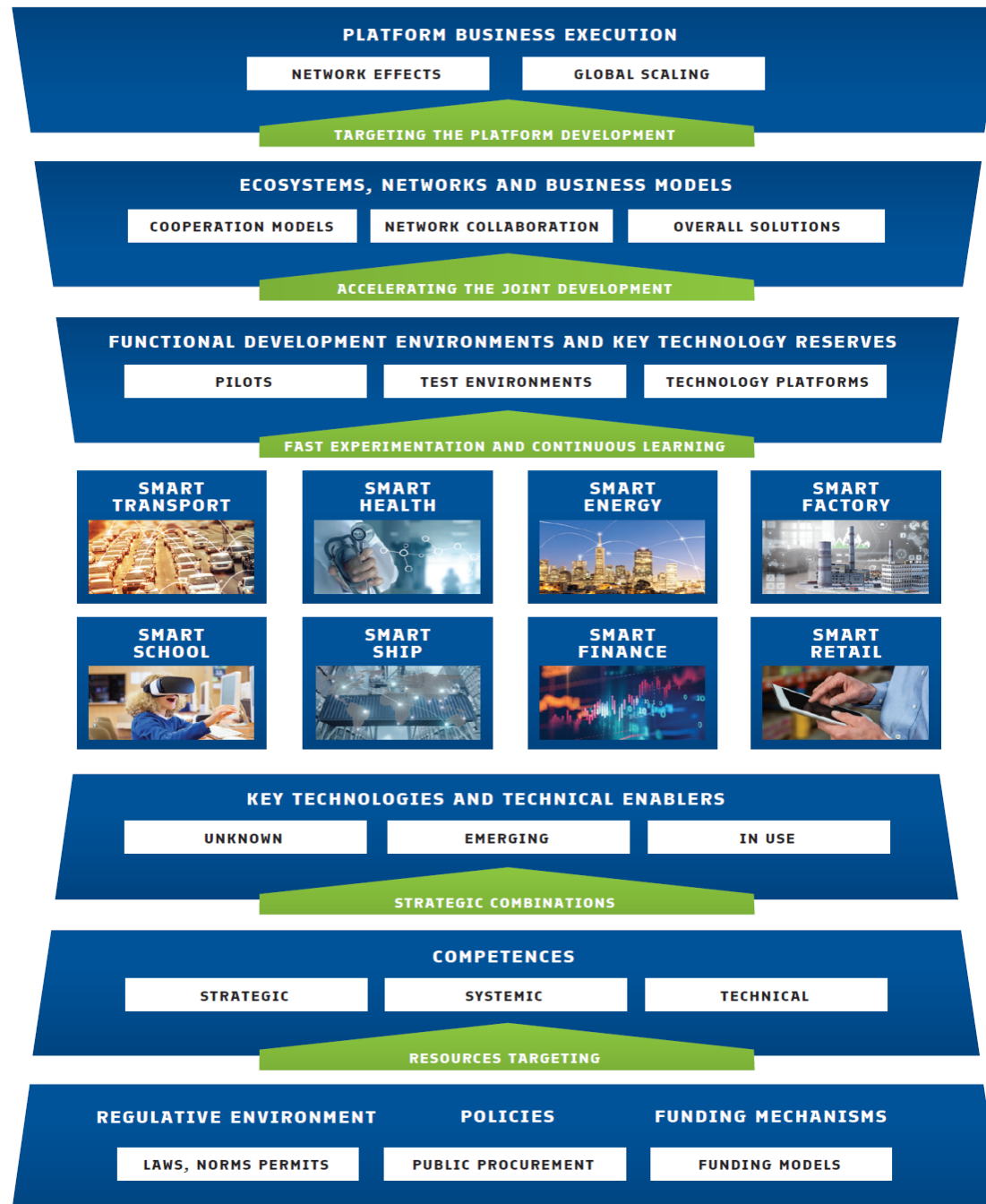


Long period of Growth – What happens after COVID-19

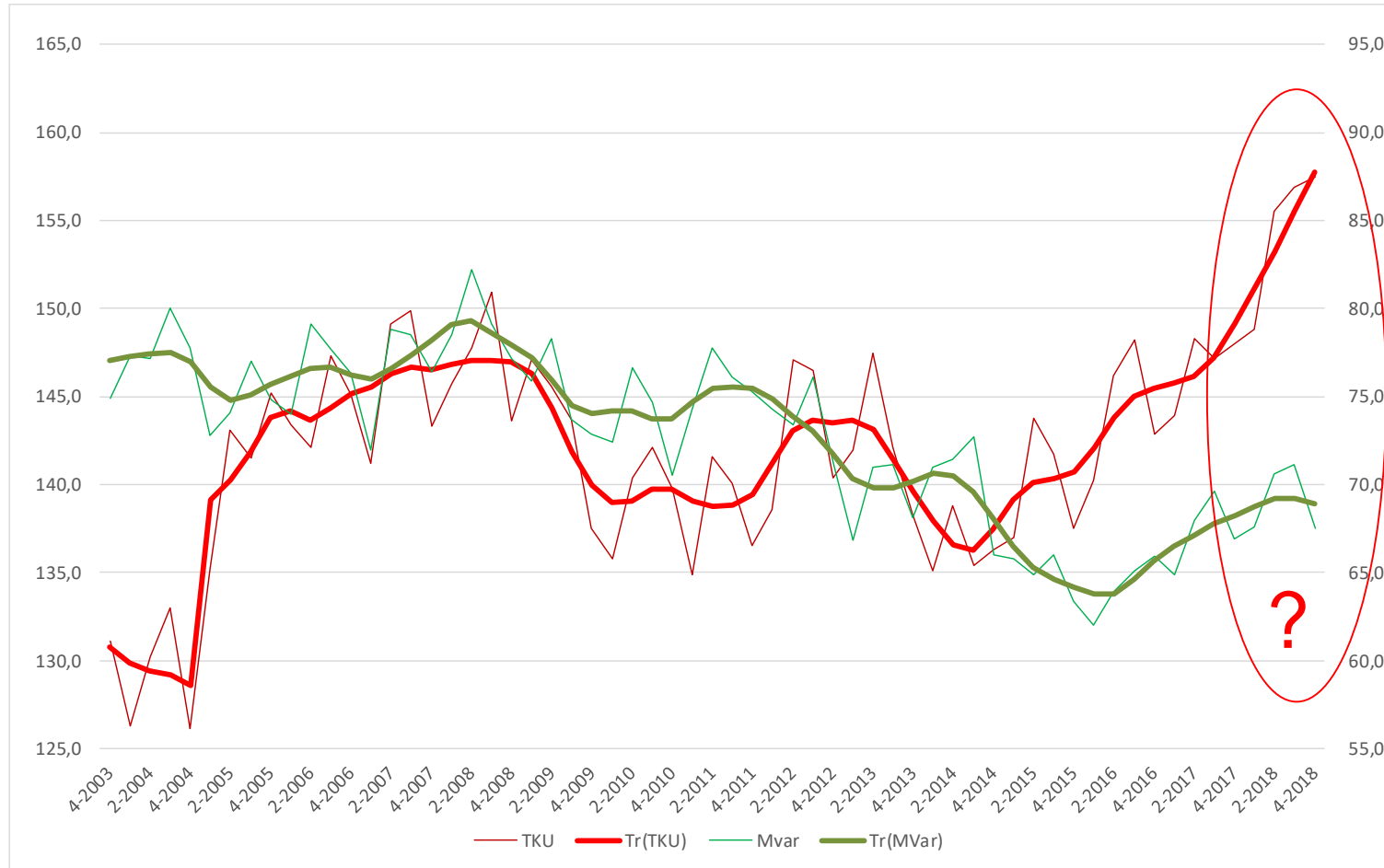
Turnover trends by industry in the Turku sub-region Jan 2010–Jan 2021

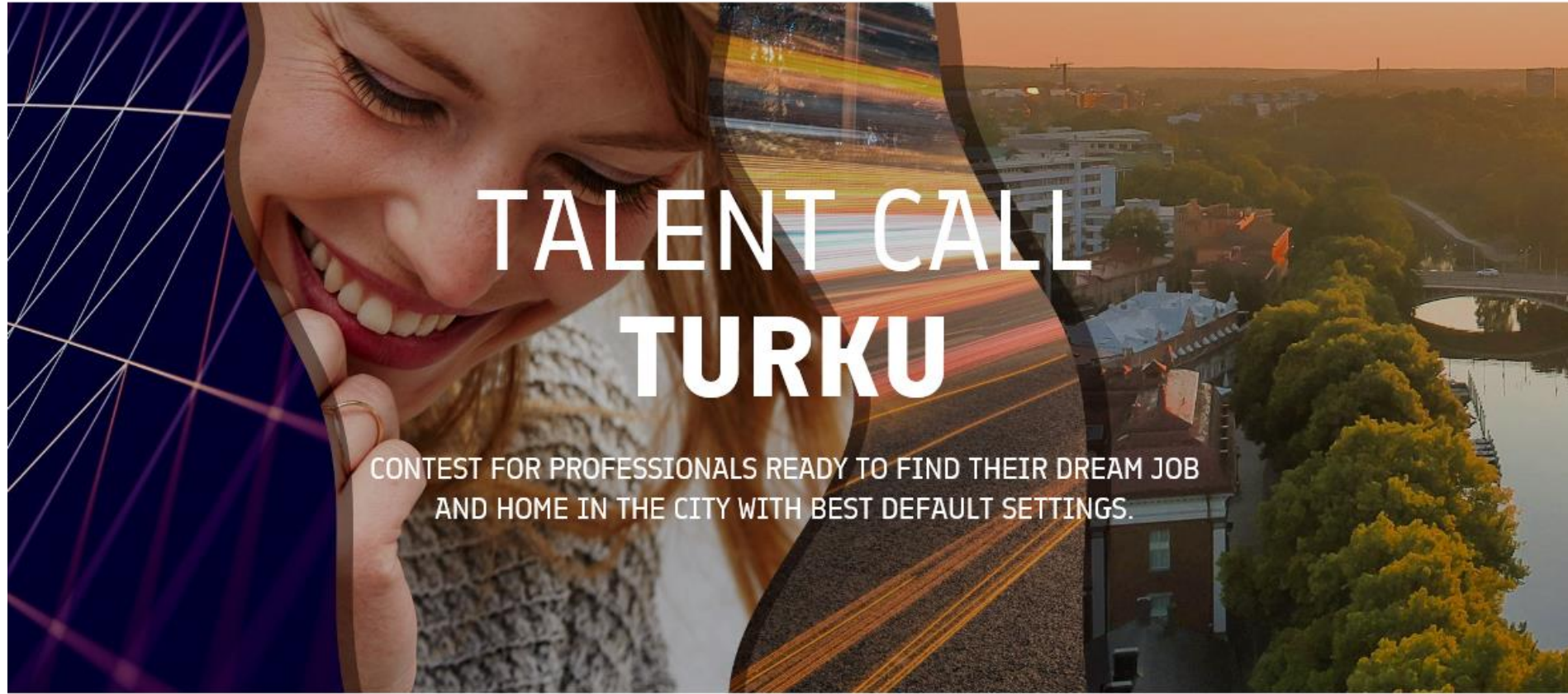
