Education and training

You learn the skills you need in the job. We will take your wishes into account, but offer you work in a field where employees are needed. Education and training is designed for your needs and those of the job.

A job

Together with employers we have found hundreds of jobs that are also suitable for those who have just started to learn the Finnish language. Companies are prepared to hire employees as long as they are sufficiently skilled and motivated.

Support to follow your path

We advise participants of the programme in the Finnish, English, Arabic and Somali languages. The programme will give you advice on matters relating to work and study for three years, also after you have found a job.

Language training

In the programme you will learn the Finnish language in real-life situations instead of just in a classroom. At work you may have the advantage of belonging to a working community which helps in learning the language.

Services of the TE Office

While participating in the programme, you will still be a customer of the TE Office. The Office will find out whether you are entitled to unemployment benefits during the studies and workplace training. After the training period, you may have an opportunity to get a job for which the employer pays you the regular wages.
